OPTION-CUM-PREFERENCE FORM

COMBINED HINDI TRANSLATORS EXAMINATION, 2025

F. No. HQ-C11017/2/2025-C-1: The candidates may refer to the Notice dated 05.06.2026, Corrigendum dated 18.07.2025 and Addendum dated 27.06.2026 of Combined Hindi Translators Examination, 2025 (CHTE-2025) published by the Commission on its website. The Commission conducted Paper-I of the examination on 12.08.2025 in the Computer Based Mode. The result of Paper-I was declared on 04.11.2025 for shortlisting the candidates for appearing in Paper-II of examination which was held on 14.12.2025. The Commission declared result of Paper-II on 04.06.2026 to shortlist candidates for PET/PST for the post of Sub Inspector (Hindi Translator) in Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF).

2. Before the declaration of First Round of Tentative Allocation (FRTA)/ result, Option-cum-Preference(s) for post(s)/ department(s) are required to be submitted by those candidates who have appeared in Paper-II of examination. Accordingly, all candidates, who have appeared in Paper-II, are advised to submit their Option-cum-Preference(s) for post(s)/ department(s) for CHTE-2025 through their respective 'CANDIDATE LOGIN' on the website i.e., <https://ssc.gov.in> wherein facility of submission of Option-cum-Preference for post(s)/ department(s) will be available under 'My Application Tab', which will remain active during the period from **08.09.2026 (23:00 hrs) to 11.09.2026 (23:00 hrs)**.

3. Candidates may please note that the Option-cum-Preference can be revised only during the aforesaid period and Option-cum-Preference last submitted by the candidate will be treated as final. **Candidates must ensure that after filling their preference, they must**

submit the form by clicking the “SUBMIT” button. Candidates, who fail to exercise their Option-cum-Preference during the aforesaid period, shall not be given any further opportunity for submission of their Option-cum-Preference and such candidates will not be considered for inclusion in the FRTA/final selection. Therefore, the candidates who have appeared in Paper-II are required to **mandatorily** exercise their Option-cum-Preference for consideration of their candidature in the FRTA/final selection in CHTE-2025.

4. PwBD candidates must ensure that they submit preference for only those posts which are identified as suitable for their disabilities. Allocation of posts will be made as per the provisions of the Notice of examination and on the basis of 'merit-cum-preference of posts'. The candidature of a PwBD candidate will get cancelled by the User Department concerned if he/ she get selected for a post which is not identified as suitable for his/ her disabilities.

5. Before exercising their preference of posts, candidates must go through the Notice, Corrigendum and Addendum of examination. All candidates are requested to ensure that they fulfill the requisite Physical and Medical Standards for the post before submitting the preference form. The candidature of a candidate may get cancelled by the User Department concerned if he/she get selected for a post and later on it is found that he/she doesn't meet the requisite Physical and/or Medical Standard of the post.

6. Candidates, who do not submit their post preference(s) on the website of the Commission within the stipulated time, will not be considered for any post in the FRTA/Final Result. Such candidates shall not be provided with another opportunity to exercise preference for posts and he/she will be solely responsible for the same. Any grievance received in this regard in any form like Post, Fax, Email, by hand, etc. shall not be entertained by the Commission and will be summarily rejected.
